A LOT OF - MUCH - MANY

- Si usano per esprimere <u>quantità grandi</u> (<u>molto/a molti/e</u>);
- Si usano solo davanti ai <u>sostantivi</u> (cioè nomi);
- Davanti agli aggettivi si usa VERY

Numerabile Non
plurale numerabile

Esempio: AFFERMATIVA → A lot of books → A lot of milk

NEGATIVA → Many books → Much milk

INTERROGATIVA → Many books → Much milk

+AFFERMATIVA → There are A LOT OF books (countable)

There is A LOT OF milk (uncountable)

-NEGATIVA → There aren't MANY books (countable)

There isn't MUCH milk (uncountable)

Are thereMANY book? (countable)

Is thereMUCH milk? (uncountable)
