AND

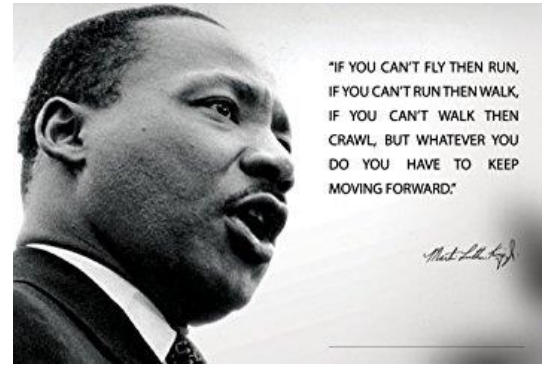
