Il verbo **HAVE GOT** si usa per parlare di ciò che si possiede, di rapporti di parentela e per descrivere le persone fisicamente. **Attenzione**, nelle risposte brevi non si mette il GOT.

I have got	Io ho
You have got	Tu hai
He has got	Egli - Lui ha
She has got	Ella - Lei ha
It has got	Esso ha

+ AFFERMATIVA CONTRATTA	
I've got	Io ho
You've got	Tu hai
He's got	Egli - Lui ha
She's got	Ella - Lei ha
It's got	Esso ha
We've got	Noi abbiamo
You've got	Voi avete
They've got	Essi hanno

- NEGATIVA ESTESA	
I have not got	Io non ho
You have not got	Tu non hai
He has not got	Egli - Lui non ha
She has not got	Ella - Lei non ha
It has not got	Esso non ha
We have not got	Noi non abbiamo
You have not got	Voi non avete
They have not got	Essi non hanno

- NEGATIVA CONTRATTA	
I haven't got	Io non ho
You haven't got	Tu non hai
He hasn't got	Egli - Lui non ha
She hasn't got	Ella - Lei non ha
It hasn't got	Esso non ha
We haven't got	Noi non abbiamo
You haven't got	Voi non avete
They haven't got	Essi non hanno
